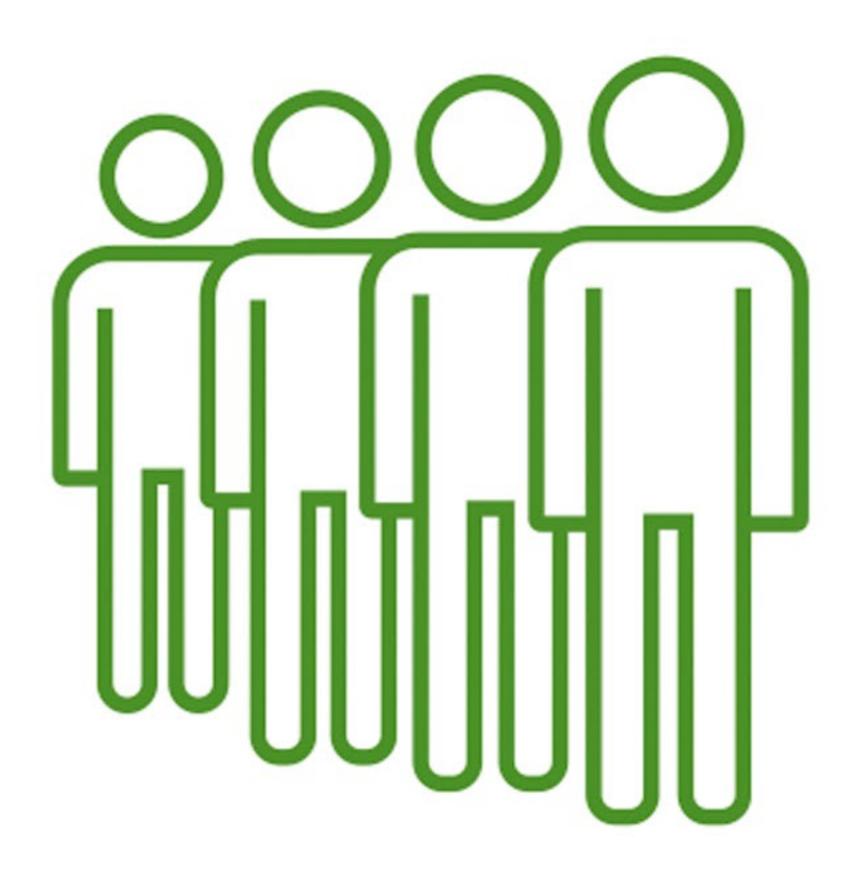
We continue to source more than 95% of our retail products from local suppliers.
